

The Centre for Pediatric Pain Research is an international leader in children's pain research. The interdisciplinary research conducted by our faculty, students, and staff tackles many facets of children's acute and chronic pain. We are committed to conducting high-quality research on how to better understand, assess, and manage children's pain and translating this research into improved practice.

The International Forum on Pediatric Pain began in 1996, organized by the faculty of the Centre for Pediatric Pain Research. They hoped to create a multidisciplinary, stimulating, and educational workshop with researchers from around the world. Since then, each Forum has brought together scientists and clinicians for plenary lectures, interactive workshops, and peer-reviewed poster sessions. Held at White Point Beach Resort, IFPP offers a quaint, relaxed atmosphere which allows for networking between colleagues and sharing of current research in all areas of pediatric pain.

White Point Beach Resort was built originally as a hunting and fishing lodge in 1928, word spread quickly about the experience White Point offered. Many families returned annually, staying one month or more, occupying the same cabin and their regular table in the dining room, overlooking the kilometre of boulder-dotted white sand beach.

On November 12, 2011, tragedy struck. The beloved main lodge burnt to the ground, reducing 83 years of history to ashes. Immediately, the decision was made to rebuild. In 2012, guestrooms and cottages also underwent refreshing with amenities expanded.

On November 8, 2012, they reopened with their new main lodge, created by and of Nova Scotia products and skills. As guests relax by a beach stone fireplace, the familiarity of the original building, and the expanded panoramic views of the beach only enhance the appreciation of that timeless vista.
