Submission Guidelines:

- 300 word limit
- 12 point font
- Word (.doc/x) or .pdf format
- Include (as appropriate): **Title; Authors; Author Affiliations; Author contact information; Objective; Design; Setting; Participants; Procedures; Measures; Results; Conclusions; References; Citation (if previously published).**

Abstracts will not be published, so presentation does not preclude submission to another meeting before or after IFPP. Authors will be emailed notification of acceptance of their posters in early May. Early conference registration will be open shortly and will be announced when available.
